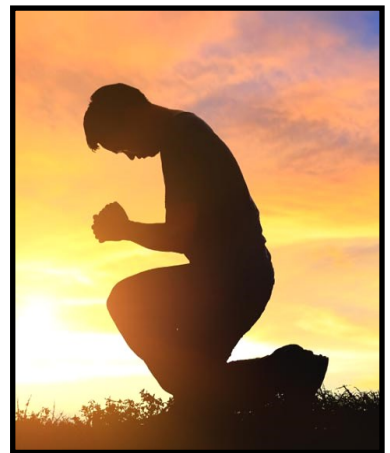

A-B-C-D-E-F Prayers

This newsletter was begun almost 12 years ago to encourage everyone in the territory to remember our folks overseas and to pray for them. Since then 88 different officers and lay personnel have been or continue to serve. They have served in more than 31 countries which circle the globe. 21 children have been alongside their parents. Your prayer support has been an important part in all of this. On countless occasions we have had feedback expressing appreciation for the prayer support. We are sharing this to assure you that your prayers are not in vain and want to encourage you to keep them going. Recently we received a little booklet put out by the Navigators, a group that was launched in 1933 to evangelize and now counts more than 5,000 missionaries laboring to fulfill The Great Commission at home and around the world.

In this booklet, we found the A-B-C-D-E-F Prayer. The apostle Paul, the first great missionary, gives at least 6 ways to pray for missionaries:

- Pray for Acceptance by other missionaries, each focused and called by God, but at times with different ideas about how to reach a particular group of people. (Romans 15:31)
- Pray for Boldness when it comes to presenting the good news. (Ephesians 6:19)
- Pray for Clarity to communicate the Gospel clearly, so the message is clearly understood. (Colossians 4:4)
- Pray for Deliverance from the attack of the enemy, from whatever direction the attack may come. (Romans 15:31)
- Pray for Extension so the ministry will extend beyond its current boundaries. (Colossians 4:3)
- Pray for Fruitfulness to ensure the gospel spreads, is accepted and takes root. (II Thessalonians 3:1)

Keep those prayers going!
