### HANG THE OVERSEAS OFFICERS!

Yes, this is what we are suggesting. Every Corps should hang their photos up on a Missionary Prayer Board and remember them regularly.

About 10 years ago we offered what we called the “Missionary Board Challenge” and perhaps it is time to bring it up again. Many Corps around the territory have a Missionary Prayer Board, ideally with a local person taking on the responsibility. This can be a person of any age and it has been found that young people do a great job at it!

If you do not yet have a board, and even if you do, make sure that it is located in a place where it is seen regularly. In the hallway before your chapel or in the multi-purpose room are great locations. It is also very important that the information be up to date (now is the time to do this as there have been recent changes and before you get too far into Christmas). Some Corps have even gone as far as to remember one of our Overseas Officer couples each week and feature them in the program with special prayer during the offering time Sunday mornings. This also helps to form a relationship with those we support not only in prayer but in World Services giving. Letting the Overseas Officers know that you pray for them will encourage them and be a blessing.

Now on to the challenge: YOUR MISSIONARY PRAYER BOARD can include so much more than just our overseas personnel: Look at this list and think about including information about any of the following: the country supported through “Partners in Mission” in your Division, Childrens’ homes in Mexico supported by Women’s Ministries, Child Sponsorship, anyone in the corps who has family members overseas in ministry, serving in the military, young people on mission trips, etc. Even disaster work done overseas could be spotlighted. The Southern Spirit, “All the World”, as well as other SA magazines, provide articles and great photos....Not to mention all the information available on line. Think about it and hopefully do something.....share what happens and bless and inspire others to do the
