**Term began:** July 1, 2018

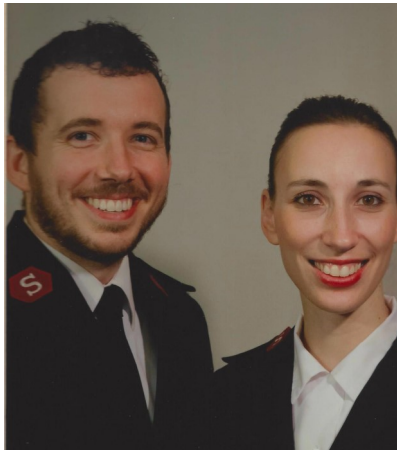
