REVEREND DR. KEVIN M. WATSON



The Reverend Dr. Kevin M. Watson is Associate Professor of Wesleyan & Methodist Studies at Candler School of Theology. In addition to his role as Candler, he is a member of the faculty at the Graduate Division of Religion. Prior to joining the Candler faculty in 2014, Dr. Watson taught at Seattle Pacific University and Perkins School of Theology.

Rev. Dr. Watson received the 2020 Smith/Wynkoop Book Award from the Wesleyan Theological Society. Named in honor of the outstanding scholarly contributions of Nazarene Historian Timothy L. Smith and theologian Mildred Bangs Wynkoop. The award recognizes a recent publication of distinction in a research area related to the

Wesleyan/Holiness tradition that has helped the tradition to be better understood and/or promoted.

His research and writings focus on the role of small group formation in the history of Methodism and theological transition in American Methodism. In addition to writing articles for both scholarly and popular publications, Watson is the author of four books including: Perfect Love, The Class Meeting, Pursuing Social Holiness, Old or New School Methodism?, A Blueprint for Discipleship, and The Band Meeting (co-authored with Scott Kisker). He is currently working on a book about the pan-Methodist history of the Wesleyan tradition in the United States. He has also published academic articles in multiple scholarly journals and a variety of ecclesial print and online publications. He enjoys freelance writing on contemporary issues facing the church, small group dynamics, Christian discipleship, and the theology and pursuit of holiness.

Rev. Dr. Watson is an ordained elder in the Oklahoma Conference of The United Methodist Church. One of his deepest desires is to see people know God's perfect love for them, find freedom from sin and shame, and move from merely surviving to absolutely thriving. He lives in Lilburn, GA with his wife Melissa and three children.
